- X Photos of you drinking alcohol or smoking

Important: if you wouldn't show a photo to your employer, please do not include it in your photo page.

- ✓ Details about **your family** (*your parents, if you have brothers or sisters*)
- ✓ Explain **why** you want to come to Australia
- ✓ Explain **why** you want to be a Demi Pair and **why** a family should choose you as their Demi Pair
- ✓ Your childcare **experience**
- ✓ Your **hobbies** and **interests**
- ✓ Your **plans for the future** (*e.g. university, career*)

Please clearly hand-write this letter and do not use a translator. You do not need to write more than two pages. You can use the template provided or you can be creative and design your own letter.
