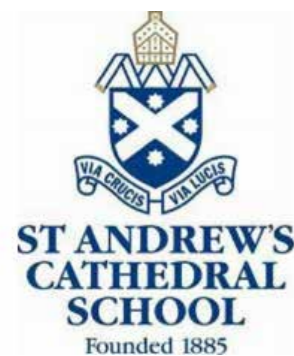

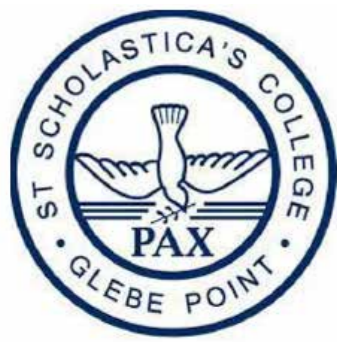

Students graduating from Year 10 achieve the International Baccalaureate IB Middle Years Programme Certificate.

In Years 11 and 12, students can either undertake the IB Diploma Programme (IBDP) or the NESA Higher School Certificate. The academic performance of IBDP students at SPGS has been outstanding for the past ten years. The average score is 39/45, which is equivalent to approximately ATAR 90.

Working with outstanding teachers and visiting specialists, SPGS students engage in competitions, festivals and tours, musicals, camps and exhibitions both on campus and offsite. Extensive facilities offer elegant spaces for creativity, performance and play – including galleries, performance and dance studios, music production studios, photomedia and digital media studios, indoor sports centre and extensive playing fields.
