#### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:**

- Minimum of 18 years of age
- Minimum Year 12 (Higher School Certificate) or equivalent LLN
- Have an IELTS or equivalent score of 6.0 with a minimum score of 5.5 in each band
- Access to a laptop or tablet for home and classroom use
- Be able to obtain a: Police Check and NDIS Worker Screening Check
- Evidence of up-to-date relevant vaccinations

#### Work Placement

Students are required to complete 120 hours of direct support work in an aged care, home and community, disability or community service organisation.
