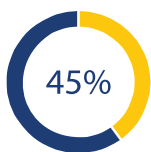
This course includes work placement, where you will gain industry knowledge and practical skills that get you job ready in a career where you can make a real difference in the lives of people in community, home, or residential care.

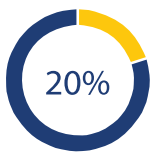
